Information and Guidelines

Wesleyan Chapel wishes to provide your child with the safest and most loving care possible. We hope that parents will have a sense of peace while trusting the nursery staff to care for your little ones. We wish to promote unity and understanding between parents and our nursery staff. To accomplish this, we ask for your support and cooperation with the following guidelines:

Sign-in Procedure

- Always complete the sign-in sheet in the nursery. This information is vital, as it will enable us to better serve you and your child.
- Please comment on any allergies, needed feedings, or any other specifics that will help the staff care for your child.

Label

- Please label everything! This ensures that your child's belongings can be identified and your child will readily receive what he/she needs. Please store your child's belongings in a cubby provided.

Diaper Bags

- Come prepared. Please include wipes, diapers/pull-ups, labeled prepared bottles, comfort items, and a change of clothes. These items are of especially important in providing quality care for your little one.
- Please do not bring toys from home. Sharing can be traumatic for the little ones when it involves a cherished toy. We strive to provide quality toys and activities for your children.

Attendance

- Your child is welcome in the nursery as soon as he/she has completed the first round of Polio and DTP shots. It is also a good idea to get your pediatrician's approval.
- Please refer to our health and wellness guidelines when unsure about whether your child is well enough to attend that day.
- The nursery is staffed with 3-5 caregivers and volunteers.

Nursery Staff

- Nursery Caregivers are paid and interviewed by the Staff Parrish Committee Chairperson. We feel fortunate to employ a very committed and loving staff. Your children are in excellent hands.
- Nursery volunteers give their time, so parents are able, to embrace the worship experience. We ask that all parents that utilize the nursery volunteer a Sunday so that all parents may enjoy their worship experience.
- Nursery Caregivers arrive at 8:15 and remain until 12:30.
- Nursery Caregivers and volunteers are trained in Safe Sanctuary Policies.
